Class of 2020 - Junior Privilege

During the 2018–19 school year, all juniors who meet the criteria stated below will be permitted to go to the 11th and 12th grade Commons or cafeteria during their study hall period only.

Criteria for participation:

1. Juniors who have any incomplete grades, or who earned a grade below “C” in a course during the second semester or fourth quarter of their sophomore year are excluded from this privilege for the first quarter of their junior year. Likewise, a junior who receives a grade below “C” in a course during any quarter will lose his/her junior privilege for the following quarter. A junior may have his/her junior privilege reinstated upon review by the administration only after passing all classes with a grade of “C” or higher during the previous quarter.
2. In the event that a teacher or group of teachers determines that the student is in need of academic intervention (*even after a single course assessment*), an Academic Lab prescription may be written and that student must attend study hall (in the Academic Hub) for the time period prescribed.
3. Juniors must have the parent permission form below signed and on file in the Academic Hub in order to exercise the junior privilege.
4. The privilege applies to **study hall periods only**. Teachers may not grant approval for use of this privilege for other than study hall periods. **Juniors who are Teacher Assistants may not exercise junior privilege during their study hall.**
5. The privilege will be suspended for one day if juniors are tardy to their next class. Repeated tardiness may lead to revocation of the privilege for the quarter or semester.
6. Juniors exercising the junior privilege must be **in the 11th and 12th grade Commons or the Café** during their junior privilege or report to study hall (in the Academic Hub) **at the beginning of the period. Juniors may not be in the halls or other locations on campus.**
7. Juniors must sign in and sign out in the Academic Hub **before and after** exercising their junior privilege. Failure to do so will result in a one-week suspension of the privilege. Repeated offenses may result in longer suspensions or revocation of the junior privilege.
8. All normal school rules apply while juniors are exercising their junior privilege. The administration reserves the right to temporarily suspend or permanently revoke a student’s junior privilege for disciplinary or academic reasons.
